Keeping Faith With the Greatest Generation Military Retirees Act - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to waive the monthly part B premium (Supplementary Medical Insurance Benefits for the Aged and Disabled) with respect to: (1) an individual who is entitled to military retired or retainer pay based upon service that began before December 7, 1956; and (2) the spouse, widow, or widower of such individuals.

- **Mar 7, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 1, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 28, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 28, 2007:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E424)
- **Feb 28, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
