Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6003) to reauthorize Amtrak.

- Jun 10, 2008: POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1253, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 1253 and by voice vote, announced that the ayes prevailed. Mr. Sessions demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 1253 until later in the legislative day.
- Jun 10, 2008: On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 227 185 (Roll no. 391). (consideration: CR H5141)

It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure now printed in the bill.
