- Jun 10, 2008: The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except clauses 9 and 10 of rule XXI.

 The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Science and Technology now printed in the bill shall be considered as an original bill for the purpose of amendment.
- Jun 10, 2008: Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 233.
