Encourages each city and state to adopt laws to prohibit discrimination and harassment against students, teachers, and other school staff regardless of their sexual orientation and gender identity and expression.

### **Actions Timeline**

- Jul 9, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Early Childhood, Elementary, and Secondary Education.
- May 4, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties.
- Apr 23, 2007: Introduced in House
- Apr 23, 2007: Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
