- **Jun 26, 2008:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 24, 2008:** Mr. Cleaver moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Jun 24, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H5977-5979)
- **Jun 24, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1271.
- **Jun 24, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Price (GA) objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
