Summary (as of Sep 17, 2008)

Commends the extraordinary contributions of those who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces.

Recognizes: (1) that the United States has an affirmative duty to care for the men and women who have so served; and (2) the efforts of the National Association of State Veterans Homes in providing veterans with high-quality care.

Commends efforts made by state veterans homes for the past 120 years in ensuring that veterans receive the highest quality of care worthy of their sacrifices.

- **Sep 15, 2008:** Mr. Filner moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Sep 15, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H8068-8071)
- **Sep 15, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1335.
- **Sep 15, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Stearns objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
- **Jul 10, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 10, 2008:** Referred to the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs.
