- **Sep 18, 2008:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR 9/17/2008 H8319)
- **Sep 18, 2008:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Sep 17, 2008:** Mr. McDermott moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Sep 17, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H8319-8324)
- **Sep 17, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1432.
- **Sep 17, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Weller objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
- **Sep 15, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 15, 2008:** Referred to the House Committee on Ways and Means.
