Summary (as of Jun 11, 2007)

Prohibits the Department of Defense (DOD) from selling any parts for the F-14 fighter aircraft (parts), whether through the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service or through another DOD agency or element.

Provides an exception with respect to the sale of such parts to a U.S. museum or similar organization involved in the preservation of F-14 fighter aircraft for historical purposes.

Prohibits the issuance of any license for the export of such parts to a non-U.S. person or entity.

- **Jun 11, 2007:** Ms. Giffords moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended.

- **Jun 11, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 1441.
- **Jun 11, 2007:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jun 11, 2007:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H6202)
