Tom Lantos Human Rights Commission Establishment Resolution - Establishes in the House of Representatives the Tom Lantos Human Rights Commission which shall promote in a nonpartisan manner internationally recognized human rights norms.

Authorizes appropriations for the House Committee on Foreign Affairs to provide staff and resources for the Commission.

- **Sep 24, 2008:** On motion to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR 9/23/2008 H8638-8639)
- **Sep 24, 2008:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Sep 23, 2008:** Mr. Scott (GA) moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **Sep 23, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H8638-8643)
- **Sep 23, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1451.
- **Sep 23, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Ms. Ros-Lehtinen objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
