Summary (as of Jun 12, 2007)

Refinery Investment Tax Assistance Act of 2007 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow: (1) for the expensing of the entire cost of certain liquid fuels refinery property (currently, only 50% of such cost can be expensed); and (2) a fiveyear recovery period for the depreciation of certain petroleum refining property.
