Actions Timeline

- **Apr 18, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Readiness.

- **Mar 29, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
