Summary (as of Mar 29, 2007)

CSRS Retirement Repayment Technical Correction Act of 2007 - Exempts federal employees and Members of Congress from the Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) interest repayment requirement with respect to retirement contribution amounts withdrawn between October 1, 1990-February 28, 1991.

Makes such exemption effective as if included in the enactment of the Omnibus Budget and Reconciliation Act of 1990.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 16, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Workforce, Post Office, and the District of Columbia.
- **Mar 29, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 29, 2007:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E695)
- **Mar 29, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on House Administration, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
