Actions Timeline

- **Jun 8, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Domestic and International Monetary Policy, Trade, and Technology.
- **May 4, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration, Citizenship, Refugees, Border Security, and International Law.
- **Mar 30, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 30, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
