Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2008 - Makes FY2008 appropriations for the: (1) Department of Agriculture; (2) Food and Drug Administration; (3) Commodity Futures Trading Commission; and (4) Farm Credit Administration.

Specifies certain uses and limits on or prohibitions against the use of funds appropriated by this Act.
