Summary (as of Jan 4, 2007)

Amends the Pension Protection Act of 2006 to require commercial passenger airline pension plan sponsors electing not to utilize the alternative funding schedule to use an interest rate of 8.25% in determining the funding target for each of the 10 plan years (rather than the segmented interest rates calculated on the basis of the corporate bond yield curve).
