Summary (as of Apr 19, 2007)

Municipal Illegal Immigration Relief Act of 2007 - Authorizes grants to local governmental units for increased expenses incurred in responding to the needs of undocumented immigrants, including: (1) law enforcement; (2) health care; (3) inmate transportation; and (4) jail overcrowding.

- May 4, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- Apr 20, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- Apr 19, 2007: Introduced in House
- Apr 19, 2007: Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
