Summary (as of Apr 19, 2007)

Montgomery G.I. Bill Improvement Act of 2007 - Exempts enlisted personnel in pay grade E-5 or below from the reduction in pay for contributions (premiums) under the Montgomery GI Bill educational assistance program.

Allows individuals serving on active duty a one-year opportunity to withdraw a previous election not to receive such educational assistance.

Actions Timeline

- Jun 20, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- Apr 23, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- Apr 19, 2007: Introduced in House
- Apr 19, 2007: Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E800)
- Apr 19, 2007: Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
