Summary (as of May 7, 2007)

Authorizes the Secretary of the military department concerned to furnish up to \$250 worth of civilian clothing and luggage to a member of the Armed Forces, or to reimburse the member up to such amount for the purchase of such civilian clothing and luggage, for use for travel in connection with a medical evacuation. (Under current law \$250 is allowed, but only for furnishing civilian clothing or reimbursement for such clothing.)
