Summary (as of Jun 16, 2008)

Green McAdoo School National Historic Site Study Act of 2008 - Directs the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the site of Green McAdoo School in Clinton, Tennessee, so as to evaluate the national significance of the site and the suitability and feasibility of designating it as a unit of the National Park System.

Requires such study to: (1) include cost estimates for any necessary acquisition, development, operation, and maintenance of the site; and (2) identify alternatives for the management, administration, and protection of the site.

- **Jun 16, 2008:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 794.
- **May 7, 2008:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Apr 9, 2008:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee on National Parks. Hearings held. With printed Hearing: S.Hrg. 110-480.
- **Oct 19, 2007:** Introduced in Senate
- **Oct 19, 2007:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
