Summary (as of Jan 29, 2008)

Sales Tax Holiday Act of 2008 - Directs the Secretary of the Treasury to reimburse each state that elects to participate in a sales tax holiday period (beginning after April 3, 2008, and ending before April 14, 2008) for 60% of the amount of state and local sales tax payable and not collected during such period.
