Summary (as of Mar 27, 2007)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 835 (Hawaiian Homeownership Opportunity Act of 2007).

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 27, 2007:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H3087-3089)
- **Mar 27, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 269.
- **Mar 27, 2007:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H3088)
- **Mar 27, 2007:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of the debate on H.Res. 269, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Sessions objected to the voice vote based upon the absence of a quorum. The Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption until later in the legislative day. The point of no quorum is considered as withdrawn.
- **Mar 27, 2007:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3098)
- **Mar 27, 2007:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 234 - 188 (Roll no. 192).(text: CR H3087)
- **Mar 27, 2007:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 234 - 188 (Roll no. 192). (text: CR H3087)
- **Mar 27, 2007:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Mar 26, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 26, 2007:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-73, by Mr. Hastings (FL).
- **Mar 26, 2007:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 835 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Mar 26, 2007:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 33.
