Requests that the President issue a proclamation each year recognizing the anniversary of the birth of President Abraham Lincoln.

Encourages state and local governments and local educational agencies to devote sufficient time to study and appreciate the reverence and respect Abraham Lincoln had for the significance and importance of the Declaration of Independence in the development of American history, jurisprudence, and the spread of freedom around the world.

- Feb 13, 2008: Received in the Senate and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
- Feb 12, 2008: Mr. Butterfield moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- Feb 12, 2008: Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H844-847)
- Feb 12, 2008: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 281.
- Feb 12, 2008: At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
