Summary (as of Jul 25, 2007)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Declares that it is the policy of the United States not to: (1) establish any military installation or base for providing for the permanent stationing of U.S. Armed Forces in Iraq; and (2) exercise U.S. control over Iraqi oil resources.

Prohibits any funds made available by any Act of Congress from being obligated or expended to: (1) establish any military installation or base for providing for the permanent stationing of U.S. Armed Forces in Iraq; or (2) exercise U.S. economic control of the oil resources of Iraq.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 26, 2007:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations.
- **Jul 25, 2007:** Mr. Ackerman moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Jul 25, 2007:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H8405-8411)
- **Jul 25, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 2929.
- **Jul 25, 2007:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
