Summary (as of Jul 10, 2007)

Home Energy Assistance Targeted for Seniors Act - Amends the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 to rename it the Low-Income and Senior Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981.

Redefines low-income households as households with incomes which do not exceed that of state median income, with at least 50% of the household income attributable to persons who are at least 65 years old.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 11, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Healthy Families and Communities.
- **Jul 10, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 10, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 10, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Air Quality.
