Summary (as of Jul 12, 2007)

Directs the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to pay to each individual entitled to basic educational assistance under the Montgomery GI Bill and pursuing a program of education with a focus on science, technology, engineering, or math a lump-sum payment of \$2,000 per academic year, or fraction thereof for enrollment lasting less than a year. Makes such amount in addition to any other educational assistance to which the individual is entitled.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 8, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jul 23, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **Jul 12, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 12, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
