Summary (as of Jun 11, 2008)

Children's Health Protection Act of 2008 - Amends the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), the Public Health Service Act, and the Internal Revenue Code to prohibit a group health plan from imposing any preexisting condition exclusion for individuals who have not attained 19 years of age.

Applies such requirement to coverage offered in the individual market.

Actions Timeline

- Jun 11, 2008: Introduced in Senate
- Jun 11, 2008: Read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions.
