Summary (as of Jul 27, 2007)

Equitable Access for DC Hunters Act of 2007 - Authorizes the chief executive of Maryland and the chief executive of Virginia to each enter into an agreement with the Mayor of the District of Columbia under which: (1) any resident of the District who applies for a hunting license shall be treated as an in-state resident for purposes of the license; and (2) the Mayor of the District shall reimburse either state for revenue forgone as a result of participating in the agreement.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 7, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Workforce, Post Office, and the District of Columbia.
- **Jul 31, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Fisheries, Wildlife, and Oceans.
- **Jul 27, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 27, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
