Expresses solidarity with Israel and its democratic government.

Calls on President Carter to cease all diplomatic efforts with recognized terrorist groups.

Condemns Hamas for its support of terrorism and the slaughter of Israeli civilians and states that it should follow the path of diplomacy to bring peace to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.
