Summary (as of Sep 9, 2008)

Expresses the sense of Congress that: (1) in emergency situations children have different needs than those of adults, and nutritional deficiencies disproportionately affect children; (2) in the current global food crisis children's nutritional needs must be a humanitarian priority; and (3) the United States and the other G8 member states should continue to monitor the global food crisis' impact on children and commit to increasing their assistance to children's needs.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 11, 2008:** Received in the Senate and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations.
- **Sep 9, 2008:** Ms. Jackson-Lee moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution, as amended.
- **Sep 9, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H7866-7869)
- **Sep 9, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 344.
- **Sep 9, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
