- **May 1, 2007:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-117, by Ms. Matsui.
- **May 1, 2007:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Science and Technology now printed in the bill.
- **May 1, 2007:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 47.
