Summary (as of Sep 14, 2007)

Taxpayers' Cancer Research Funding Act of 2007- Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow taxpayers to designate on their tax returns a \$5 contribution to the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund (\$10 for joint returns).

Establishes in the Treasury the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund to award grants for breast or prostate cancer research.

Actions Timeline

- Sep 14, 2007: Introduced in House
- Sep 14, 2007: Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- Sep 14, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
