Authorizes use of approximately 36.25 acres patented to the Mammoth County Water District (now known as the Mammoth Community Water District) in Mono County, California, for any public purpose, notwithstanding the Sisk Act.

- Feb 6, 2007: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 356.
