### Summary (as of Sep 25, 2007)

Energy Efficient Appliance Tax Credit for Air Conditioners Act of 2007 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a tax credit for 25% of the cost (up to \$500) of air conditioners which meet requirements for the Energy Star program.

Terminates such credit after 2016.
