- **May 2, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **May 2, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
