- May 8, 2007: The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-137, by Mr. Cardoza.

It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform now printed in the bill.
