Yakima-Tieton Irrigation District Conveyance Act of 2007 - Directs the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain buildings and lands of the Yakima Project, Washington, to the Yakima-Tieton Irrigation District.

Directs the Secretary, if the conveyance has not been completed within 12 months, to report to Congress with an explanation and the date by which it will be completed.

- **Feb 7, 2007:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
- **Feb 6, 2007:** Mrs. Napolitano moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Feb 6, 2007:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1226-1227)
- **Feb 6, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 386.
- **Feb 6, 2007:** At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
