- Sep 17, 2008: Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- Sep 15, 2008: Mr. Scott (VA) moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.

- Sep 15, 2008: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 410.
- Sep 15, 2008: At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Issa objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
