### Summary (as of Nov 15, 2007)

William H. Rehnquist Law Center Establishment Act of 2007 - Authorizes the Attorney General to provide a grant to the University of Arizona James E. Rogers School of Law to establish the William H. Rehnquist Center on the Constitutional Structures of Government.

Requires the Law School to provide specified nonfederal contributions toward the establishment of the Law Center.

- **Feb 5, 2008:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Higher Education, Lifelong Learning, and Competitiveness.

- **Nov 15, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
