Summary (as of Jun 5, 2007)

States that Iran should immediately and unconditionally release dual Iranian-American citizens Dr. Haleh Esfandiari, Ms. Parnaz Azima, Mr. Kian Tajbakhsh, Mr. Ali Shakeri, and a fifth unnamed individual being detained against his will, replace their lost travel documents, cease its tactics of harassment, and permit them to leave Iran.
