Summary (as of Dec 6, 2007)

Medicare Chronic Care Practice Research Network Act of 2007 - Directs the Secretary of Health and Human Services to establish a Medicare Chronic Care Practice Research Network to develop and evaluate evidence-based chronic care management for Medicare beneficiaries with multiple, chronic conditions, with a focus on beneficiaries under the Medicare fee-for-service program whose care is most costly.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 10, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 6, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 6, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Dec 6, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
