Requires the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct to: (1) investigate without further delay alleged illegal conduct and violations of House rules by Representative William J. Jefferson; and (2) report its findings and recommendations to the House, including a recommendation regarding whether Representative Jefferson should be expelled from the House.

- Jun 5, 2007: DEBATE The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 452.
- Jun 5, 2007: The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H5971)
- Jun 5, 2007: POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 452, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Boehner demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
