#### **Summary** (as of Jan 23, 2008)

Maximizing the Use of Federal Funds for Job Training Act - Authorizes states with unemployment rates that equal or exceed 125% of the national unemployment rate to consolidate or transfer, without limitation, any funds made available to them under specified job training programs.

- Jan 28, 2008: Referred to the Subcommittee on Income Security and Family Support.
- Jan 23, 2008: Introduced in House
- Jan 23, 2008: Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
