Summary (as of Jan 23, 2008)

Reinstatement of the Secure Fence Act of 2008 - Amends the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 to direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to construct at least 700 miles of two-layered, 14-foot reinforced fencing along the southwest border and provide for the installation of additional physical barriers, roads, lighting, cameras, and sensors within six months of enactment of this Act.

Prohibits the inclusion of fencing in existence on January 1, 2008, as part of the fencing requirement under this Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 14, 2008:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border, Maritime, and Global Counterterrorism.
- **Jan 23, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 23, 2008:** Referred to the House Committee on Homeland Security.
