## **Actions Timeline**

- **Jul 17, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 547.
- **Jul 17, 2007:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H7866-7868)
- **Jul 17, 2007:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H7868)
- **Jul 17, 2007:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of the debate on H.Res. 547, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Hastings of Washington objected to the voice vote based upon the absence of a quorum. The Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption until later in the legislative day. The point of no quorum is considered as withdrawn.
- **Jul 17, 2007:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H7872-7873)
- **Jul 17, 2007:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 178 (Roll no. 634). (text: CR H7867)
- **Jul 17, 2007:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 232 - 178 (Roll no. 634). (text: CR H7867)
- **Jul 17, 2007:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 16, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 16, 2007:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-235, by Ms. Matsui.
- **Jul 16, 2007:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.
- **Jul 16, 2007:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 88.
