Summary (as of May 8, 2008)

Post Office Modernization Act of 2008 - Requires the Postal Service to ensure that every post office has access to running water and bathroom facilities.

Prohibits the Post Office, in making a determination whether or not to close or consolidate a post office, from considering whether the post office meets the requirements of this Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 4, 2008:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Federal Workforce, Post Office, and the District of Columbia.
- **May 8, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **May 8, 2008:** Referred to the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform.
