Observes the birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr., and pledges to advance his legacy. Encourages the U.S. people to observe his birthday, commemorate his legacy, remember his message, and rededicate themselves to his goal of a free and just United States.

- Jan 16, 2007: Mr. Convers moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- Jan 16, 2007: Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H519-532)
- Jan 16, 2007: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 61.
- Jan 16, 2007: At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
