### Summary (as of May 21, 2008)

Saving Family Homes Act of 2008 - Grants eligible mortgagors subject to foreclosure proceedings the right to continue to occupy foreclosed properties subject to the payment of fair market rent for a period of 20 years that begins upon the commencement of occupancy of such property.
