### Summary (as of Jun 10, 2008)

Fuel Freedom Act of 2008 - Requires each automobile manufactured after model year 2018 to be an alternative fueled automobile.

Makes a manufacturer liable for a civil penalty of up to \$10,000 for each automobile manufactured in violation of this requirement.
