Summary (as of Sep 27, 2007)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 3121 (Flood Insurance Reform and Modernization Act of 2007).

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 27, 2007:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H10947-10953)
- **Sep 27, 2007:** Point of order raised by Mr. Dreier on the content of the measure. Mr. Dreier stated that the provisions of H.Res. 683 violate House earmark rules. Point of order overruled by the Chair.
- **Sep 27, 2007:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 683.
- **Sep 27, 2007:** DEBATE - The House resumed debate on H. Res. 683.
- **Sep 27, 2007:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 682, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that ayes had prevailed. Ms. Matsui demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question on ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Sep 27, 2007:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H10955-10956)
- **Sep 27, 2007:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by recorded vote: 220 - 193, 1 Present (Roll no. 917). (consideration: CR H10955)
- **Sep 27, 2007:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 220 - 188, 1 Present (Roll no. 918).(text: CR H10947)
- **Sep 27, 2007:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 220 - 188, 1 Present (Roll no. 918). (text: CR H10947)
- **Sep 27, 2007:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Sep 26, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 26, 2007:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-351, by Ms. Matsui.
- **Sep 26, 2007:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee of the Whole.
- **Sep 26, 2007:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 125.
