Summary (as of Sep 10, 2008)

Child Labor Safety Act - Amends the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1998 to subject, upon conviction, an employer who willfully violates child labor requirements and prohibitions to a fine of up to \$50,000, or imprisonment for up to six months, for each employee who was the subject of such violation, or both.

Increases the maximum employer civil penalty: (1) from \$11,000 to \$50,000 for each employee who was the subject of a child labor violation; and (2) from \$50,000 to \$100,000 for each such violation that causes the death or serious injury of any employee under age 18.
